## RESOLUTION NO. 33-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$1,094,383.00 FOR FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT; DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF GIVING REQUIRED ASSURANCES AND ACTING IN CONNECTION WITH SAID APPLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is entitled to certain funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of an amount not to exceed \$1,094,383.00 (see Exhibit "A") in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for the year 2001-02 program year; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, has considered the suggestions and recommendations raised at the hearings; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the citizens of Mesquite that application be made for such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Year 2001 CDBG expenditures are hereby approved and adopted by the City of Mesquite as its 2001-02 Community Development Block Grant Program.

SECTION 2. That Ted Barron, City Manager of the City of Mesquite, is hereby authorized to file an application for funds under the Housing and Community Development Act on behalf of the City of Mesquite, Texas, and to certify all understandings and assurances required under Federal Management Circular 74-4, National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, Titles VI and VII of the Civil Rights Acts of 1964 and 1968 respectively, Executive Orders 11063 and 11246 and such other assurances as may be required.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.
