WHEREAS, their efforts have provided the foundation upon which many of our local arts groups were founded; and

WHEREAS, the Mesquite Arts Center has been a dream of thousands of arts enthusiasts over the years and draws over 100,000 people annually to events; and


WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite desires to honor Jeann and Ralph Wisenbaker with a public commemoration.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.


