

RESOLUTION NO. 59-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO GRANT "SUPPLEMENTAL PAY" IN AN AMOUNT NECESSARY TO ENSURE NO LOSS IN WAGES BETWEEN MILITARY PAY AND THE EMPLOYEE'S GROSS WAGES (EXCLUDING OVERTIME) TO ALL FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CALLED TO ACTIVE DUTY TO SERVE OUR COUNTRY IN OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM.

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to express its appreciation for the service and dedication of employees called to serve our country in Operation Enduring Freedom; and


WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate and in the best interest of the City to grant "Supplemental Pay" to all full-time employees called to active duty in Operation Enduring Freedom in an amount necessary to ensure no loss in wages between military pay and the employee's gross wages (excluding overtime) for a period of up to six (6) months from the date the employee is called to active duty in Operation Enduring Freedom.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to grant "Supplemental Pay" to all full-time employees called to active duty in Operation Enduring Freedom in an amount necessary to ensure no loss in wages between military pay and the employee's gross wages (excluding overtime) for a period of up to six (6) months from the date the employee is called to active duty to serve our country in Operation Enduring Freedom.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.
