

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUSPENDING THE PROPOSED EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE PROPOSED RATE SCHEDULES OF TXU GAS DISTRIBUTION (A DIVISION OF TXU GAS COMPANY); PROVIDING THAT THE RATE SCHEDULES OF SAID COMPANY SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED DURING THE PERIOD OF SUSPENSION; AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE HEREOF TO SAID COMPANY.

WHEREAS, TXU Gas Distribution heretofore, on March 1, 2002, filed with the City Council of the City of Mesquite its Statement of Intent, together with its rate filing package, proposing to change its rate schedules within the corporate limits of the City of Mesquite, effective on April 5, 2002 (the "proposed effective date"); and

WHEREAS, in order to allow sufficient time for the consideration of the data filed by said Company, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Mesquite to suspend, pursuant to Section 104.107(a)(1) of the Gas Utility Regulatory Act, the proposed effective date of said proposed changed rate schedules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE:

SECTION 1. That the effective date of the proposed changed rate schedules of TXU Gas Distribution is hereby suspended for a period of ninety (90) days from the proposed effective date.

SECTION 2. That the rate schedules of TXU Gas Distribution in effect within the City of Mesquite on the date on which TXU Gas Distribution filed its said Statement of Intent shall continue in force during the period of suspension provided in Section 1 hereof.


SECTION 3. That the City Secretary of the City of Mesquite is hereby directed to deliver a copy of this Resolution to TXU Gas Distribution promptly after the passage hereof.
