RESOLUTION NO. 35-2002

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS DETERMINING THAT THE EXISTING CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED FOR THE 2002 THREE-YEAR REVIEW INTERVAL.

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 4a of the Charter of the City of Mesquite provides for the City to be divided into four districts and that each third year and at least one hundred twenty days prior to the general municipal election, the governing body shall review and where necessary and permissible, alter or change the boundaries of the existing council districts for the purpose of preserving and maintaining the equal apportionment of inhabitants in each such district; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the four districts as required by Charter and determined that changes to the boundaries of the existing City Council districts are not necessary at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That having reviewed the population of the four City Council Districts in the City as required by City Charter, it is determined that the equal apportionment of inhabitants in each district has not changed so as to necessitate the altering or amending of the existing City Council districts and shall remain unchanged at this three-year review interval.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
