

RESOLUTION NO. 10-2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING PRECINCTS AND THE LOCATION OF POLLING PLACES FOR THE ANNUAL CITY ELECTION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the 78th Texas Legislature has declared that the May 2004 election shall be held on the third Saturday in May, after which time the election date will revert back to the first Saturday in May for future elections; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, has called the annual general election to be held May 15, 2004, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for Places 3, 4 and 5.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS;

SECTION 1. That the City election precincts for this election shall consist of the territory located within the corporate limits of the City bearing the following numbers, and the polling places at said election shall be as follows, to wit:



SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption.


