

RESOLUTION NO. 49-2005

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RECOGNIZING THE OBSOLESCENCE OF THE HIGH WATER OPERATIONS PLAN ADOPTED IN 1973 AND REVISED IN 1975 AND THEREBY ELIMINATING IT AS A DOCUMENT FOR USE BY THE CITY OF MESQUITE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, in 1973, a High Water Operations Plan (the "Plan") was prepared by the City Manager's office with the assistance of the Police, Fire, Public Services and Community Development departments as a guide for a coordinated response to high water conditions, and

WHEREAS, it was not the intent of the Plan to replace the City's Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Plan was to be reviewed, updated and periodically discussed by the departments involved; and


WHEREAS, the Plan was last revised in 1975, contains out of date information and has not been utilized in several years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the High Water Operations Plan prepared by the City Manager and City staff in 1973 and revised in 1975 is hereby deemed obsolete and shall not be recognized as an official operation plan or document of the City of Mesquite for any purpose.


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage.


