RESOLUTION NO. 54-2005

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE ACCEPTANCE AND FILING OF APPLICATIONS FOR ZONING, PLATS, SITE PLANS, BUILDING PERMITS AND OTHER DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS FOR NONRESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT ALONG THE MILITARY PARKWAY CORRIDOR PROVIDED FOR IN RESOLUTION NO. 33-2005 AND ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF SUCH RESOLUTION FOR A PERIOD OF TIME EXTENDING THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2006.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 33-2005 ("Resolution") adopted on August 15, 2005, provided for the temporary suspension of the acceptance and filing of applications for zoning, plats, site plans, building permits and other development applications for nonresidential development along the Military Parkway corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution also provided for the extension of the temporary suspension period in 30-day increments should additional study time be necessary; and

WHEREAS, Staff with the concurrence of the Planning and Zoning Commission is requesting such an extension to the temporary suspension period through January 31, 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE:

SECTION 1. That all of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City of Mesquite City Council and they are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this resolution as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2. That the temporary suspension provided for in Resolution No. 33-2005 is hereby extended for 30 days until January 31, 2006, along with all other provisions of such resolution.
