WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed, was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS COMBINATION TAX AND REVENUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION, SERIES 2006

The City of Mesquite does hereby give notice of intention to issue combination tax and revenue certificates of obligation, in one or more series, in the maximum principal amount not to exceed \$9,300,000, for paying all or a portion of the City's contractual obligations for the purposes of (i) constructing and improving streets, roads and alleys including related drainage, signalization, landscaping, lighting and signage; (ii) constructing, improving, equipping and renovating the City's Police/City Hall, Library, Municipal Center Building, City Art Center, Social Services Building, Fire Station No. 4 and Fire Training Building; (iii) acquiring and improving land at 1510 Crest Park for City Art Center parking; (iv) acquiring and constructing municipal airport hangars; (v) constructing and equipping public parking facilities for the convention center, exhibition hall and surrounding area, and the acquisition of land and interests in land therefor; and (vi) for paying legal, fiscal, engineering and other professional fees in connection with such projects. The City proposes to provide for the payment of such combination tax and revenue certificates of obligation from the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes in the City as provided by law, and from a limited pledge of surplus revenues of the City's Waterworks and Sewer System, remaining after payment of all operation and maintenance expenses thereof, and all debt service, reserve, and other requirements in connection with any of the City's revenue bonds or other obligations (now or hereafter outstanding), which are payable from all or any part of the Net Revenues of the City's Waterworks and Sewer System. The City Council intends to consider for passage an ordinance authorizing the issuance of combination tax and revenue certificates of obligation at a meeting to be held at 3:00 p.m. on May 1, 2006, in the City Council Chambers, at City Hall, 711 N. Galloway, Mesquite, Texas.
