RESOLUTION NO. 20-2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$103,450.00 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO REPLACE THE 24-INCH IN DIAMETER CARBON STEEL RISER PIPE WITH A NEW 24-INCH IN DIAMETER STAINLESS STEEL RISER PIPE AT THE TOWN EAST ELEVATED WATER STORAGE TANK LOCATED AT 3120 TOWNE CENTRE DRIVE AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO LANDMARK STRUCTURES I, L.P., FOR SUCH REPAIRS.

WHEREAS, the existing 24-inch diameter steel riser pipe in the Town East Elevated Tank is leaking in several locations and the condition of the pipe makes the daily operational use questionable; and

WHEREAS, the Town East Elevated Water Storage Tank is required to provide water and fire protection to our citizens and businesses and the summer demands are rapidly approaching and this elevated tank must be operational to meet these water demands; and

WHEREAS, such unforeseen damage requires an immediate expenditure of funds without having competitively bid the repairs in order to protect and preserve the public health and safety of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, such procurement is authorized without competitive bidding by Texas Local Government Code §252.022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the expenditure of \$103,450.00 without competitive bidding for emergency repairs to replace the 24-inch in diameter carbon steel riser pipe with a new 24-inch in diameter stainless steel riser pipe at the Town East Elevated Water Storage Tank located at 3120 Towne Centre Drive is hereby ratified and payment of funds to Landmark Structures I, L.P., for such repairs is hereby authorized.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is authorized to take those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this resolution.
