

RESOLUTION NO. 47-2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING AND ACKNOWLEDGING THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT YOUTH SERVICES DIVISION'S GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$55,957.00 FOR THE FAMILY ASSISTANCE SUPPORT TEAM PROGRAM; AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE AUTHORIZED OFFICER FOR THE PURPOSE OF SIGNING ALL SUBORDINATE DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite ("City Council") finds it in the best interest of its citizens that the Family Assistance Support Team Project ("Project") be operated for 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees to provide \$55,957.00 as matching funds for the said Project as required by the Project's grant application from the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the City Manager as the Authorized Officer responsible for applying for, accepting, rejecting, altering or terminating the grant on behalf of the City of Mesquite; and


WHEREAS, in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit a grant application in the amount of \$55,957.00 for the Family Assistance Support Team Project from the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division.


SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby designated Authorized Officer for the purpose of signing all subordinate documents associated with this grant.


