## RESOLUTION NO. 63-2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE EXPENDITURE \$51,850.47 TO DATE AND AUTHORIZING OF ADDITIONAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000.00 FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS ANTICIPATED THROUGH JANUARY 2, 2007, FOR A TOTAL OF \$121,850.47 IN ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO WATER MAINS CREATED BY THE CURRENT DROUGHT CONDITIONS AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS SUPPLY FOR SUCH REPAIRS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to the unforeseen current drought conditions, the ground has been extremely dry and as a result many of the older water mains have been damaged; and

WHEREAS, the current contract with Municipal Water Works Supply that expires on January 2, 2007, is insufficient to cover the actual expenses created by the drought conditions; and

WHEREAS, such conditions require ratifying a current expenditure of \$51,850.47 to date and authorizing additional funding in the amount of \$70,000.00 for repairs anticipated through January 2, 2007, the date the current contract expires, for a total of \$121,850.47 in additional funds for the emergency repairs to water mains in order to protect and preserve the property of the City; and

WHEREAS, such procurement is authorized by Texas Local Government Code § 252.022(a)(3).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the expenditure of \$51,850.47 in conjunction with City Contract No. 2006-034, Annual Supply of Water Parts, for the emergency repairs to water mains is hereby ratified and payment of funds to Municipal Water Works Supply for such services is hereby authorized.

SECTION 2. That additional funding in the amount of \$70,000.00 for emergency repairs anticipated to water mains through January 2, 2007, is hereby authorized.
