RESOLUTION NO. 71-2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF SUNNYVALE TO ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF BELT LINE ROAD AND TOWN EAST BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, the Town of Sunnyvale (the 'Town') has requested and the City of Mesquite (the 'City') has agreed to enter into an interlocal agreement regarding the operation and maintenance of the traffic signal located at the intersection of Belt Line Road and Town East Boulevard (the 'Traffic Signal'); and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, V.T.C.A., Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, provides authorization for any local government to contract with one or more local governments to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Town will reimburse the City for the operation and maintenance of the Traffic Signal; and

WHEREAS, by assuming the responsibilities of the Traffic Signal, the uniform progressive flow on Belt Line Road will be achieved when signal coordination plans and fiber optic programs are implemented in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Mesquite and the Town of Sunnyvale to assume the responsibilities of operation and maintenance of the traffic signal at Belt Line Road and Town East Boulevard.
