

RESOLUTION NO. 12-2007

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$34,920.00 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS FOR REPAIRING THE 16-INCH DIAMETER WATER LINE CROSSING IH-30 AT NORTH GALLOWAY AVENUE; AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO JIM BOWMAN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, L.P., INC., FOR SUCH REPAIRS.

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2006, a major leak was discovered on the 16-inch diameter water line crossing IH-30 at North Galloway Avenue; and

WHEREAS, due to the size of the water main and its critical function of carrying water across IH-30 and the water main's depth and location, it was necessary to hire a contractor to conduct an emergency repair of the leak; and

WHEREAS, such unforeseen damage requires an immediate expenditure of funds without having competitively bid the repairs in order to protect and preserve the public health and safety of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, such procurement is authorized without competitive bidding by Texas Local Government Code §252.022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the expenditure of \$34,920.00 without competitive bidding for emergency repairs for repairing the 16-inch diameter water line crossing IH-30 at North Galloway Avenue is hereby ratified and payment of funds to Jim Bowman Construction Company, L.P., for such repairs is hereby authorized.


SECTION 2. That the City Manager is authorized to take those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this resolution.
