

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A PROJECT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$98,700 WITH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (NCTCOG) TO IMPLEMENT A CURBSIDE RECYCLING BIN PILOT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT ALL APPROVED PROJECTS WILL COMPLY WITH THE PROJECT REQUIREMENTS OF THE NCTCOG, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (TCEQ) AND THE STATE OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is directed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to administer solid waste project funds for implementation of the NCTCOG adopted Regional Solid Waste Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for project funds under the Request for Project Applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City Manager is authorized to request project funding in the amount of \$98,700 under the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) Request for Project Applications of the Regional Solid Waste Local Project Funding Program to provide curbside recycling bins to neighborhood pilot areas, to develop and implement an educational program to promote and market the curbside bin pilot program, and act on behalf of the City of Mesquite (City) in all matters related to the project application and any subsequent project contract that may result.

SECTION 2. That the City will comply with the project requirements of the NCTCOG, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and the State of Texas.

SECTION 3. That the project funds and any project-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the project.


SECTION 4. That activities will comply with and support the adopted regional and local solid waste management plans adopted for the geographical area in which the activities are performed.


