RESOLUTION NO. 22-2008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESOUITE, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE FILING OF A PROJECT APPLICATION IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$41,682 WITH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (NCTCOG) TO IMPLEMENT A MULTI-FAMILY RECYCLING PILOT PROGRAM AND PURCHASE RECYCLING RECEPTACLES FOR ALL CITY-OWNED AND **OPERATED** FACILITIES. AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MESOUITE IN ALL FUTURE MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT ALL APPROVED WILL PROJECTS COMPLY WITH THE **PROJECT** REQUIREMENTS OF THE NCTCOG, THE **TEXAS** COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (TCEQ) AND THE STATE OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is directed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to administer solid waste project funds for implementation of the NCTCOG adopted Regional Solid Waste Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for project funds under the Request for Project Applications; and

WHEREAS, the application process required the Mayor sign and the application be filed by May 16, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

- SECTION 1. That the filing of an application to request project funding in the total amount of \$41,682 under the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) Request for Project Applications of the Regional Solid Waste Local Project Funding Program to implement a multi-family recycling pilot program and purchase recycling receptacles for all city-owned and operated facilities, and act on behalf of the City of Mesquite (City) in all matters related to the project application is hereby ratified and any subsequent project contract that may result is hereby authorized.
- SECTION 2. That the City will comply with the project requirements of the NCTCOG, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and the State of Texas.
- SECTION 3. That the project funds and any project-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the project.
- <u>SECTION 4</u>. That activities will comply with and support the adopted regional and local solid waste management plans adopted for the geographical area in which the activities are performed.
