

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ENDORSING THE MULTI-YEAR GRANT FOR THE SPEED SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROJECT FOR THREE YEARS; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THIS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite (the "City") and the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") have been sharing funding of a Speed Selective Traffic Enforcement Project ("STEP") to promote highway safety; and

WHEREAS, the proposed multi-year grant will provide funding to hire off-duty officers on an overtime basis to detect and apprehend speed limit offenders on our highways to cover three fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, for the 2008-09 fiscal year TxDOT will participate in the amount of \$77,802.50 to be supplemented by available City funds in the amount of \$21,565.45; and

WHEREAS, for the 2009-10 fiscal year TxDOT will participate in the amount of \$77,802.50 to be supplemented by City funds that will be set aside in the amount of \$21,565.45; and


WHEREAS, for the 2010-11 fiscal year TxDOT will participate in the amount of \$64,162.00 to be supplemented by City funds that will be set aside in the amount of \$35,911.43.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite hereby endorses the multi-year grant for the Selective Traffic Enforcement Project to promote highway safety.


SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents with the Texas Department of Transportation for this project.
