

RESOLUTION NO. 13-2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 61-2006 THEREBY ALLOWING CITY STAFF TO WORK WITH THE DALLAS WATER UTILITIES TO COORDINATE THE SHARING OF RIGHT-OF-WAY ALONG LAWSON ROAD.

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2006, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 61-2006 supporting a SH 190 alignment along Lawson Road as required by the Falcon's Lair Commercial Development Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on January 4, 2010, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 4073 terminating the Falcon's Lair Commercial Development Agreement; and


WHEREAS, there is no longer a contractual requirement to support the SH 190 alignment along Lawson Road; and

WHEREAS, by rescinding Resolution No. 61-2006, City staff would be able to work with the Dallas Water Utilities (DWU) to coordinate the sharing of right-of-way along Lawson Road for their Southeast Transmission Pipeline, thus minimizing the loss of developable property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:




