

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$992,799 FOR FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT; APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE PROGRAM YEAR 2010-11 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN; AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF GIVING REQUIRED ASSURANCES AND ACTING IN CONNECTION WITH SAID APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite (City) is entitled to certain funds under the Housing and Community Development Act in an amount not to exceed \$992,799 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for the 2010-11 program year as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the Mesquite City Council has considered the suggestions and recommendations that were raised at the hearings for the expenditure of the funds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the citizens of Mesquite that application be made for such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Program Year 2010-11 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Allocation, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," is hereby approved and adopted by the City of Mesquite (City) as its Program Year 2010-11 CDBG Annual Action Plan.


