

RESOLUTION NO. 11-2011

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING PRECINCTS AND THE LOCATION OF POLLING PLACES FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION/LOCAL OPTION ELECTION TO BE HELD MAY 14, 2011; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Secretary's office received petitions on February 1, 2011, from the qualified voters of the City of Mesquite, Texas, desiring that a local option election be called to permit voting for or against the legal sale of beer and wine for off-premise consumption only; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 501.032 of the Texas Election Code, the City of Mesquite shall call a local option election to consider whether to legalize the following local option election issue: the legal sale of beer and wine for off-premise consumption only, if a number of signatures of qualified voters contained in said petitions are equal to or greater than 35 percent of the registered voters in the subdivision who voted in the most recent gubernatorial election; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified to the City Council of the City of Mesquite that the number of valid signatures of qualified voters contained in said petitions is equal to or greater than 7,915, that number being 35 percent of the registered voters in the City of Mesquite who voted in the most recent gubernatorial election as determined by the Dallas County Elections Department and the Kaufman County Elections Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, has called a Special Election/Local Option Election to be held May 14, 2011, for the purpose of determining whether to legalize the local option election issue referenced above; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has entered into an agreement with the Dallas County Elections Department to hold the Special Election/Local Option Election in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Texas, the Statutes of the State of Texas and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Mesquite and shall be in conformity with the procedures set forth herein; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS;

SECTION 1. That the City election precincts for this election shall consist of the territory located within the corporate limits of the City of Mesquite, Texas, located within Dallas and Kaufman counties, bearing the following numbers and the polling places at said election shall be as follows:



None but legally qualified voters of the City of Mesquite shall be entitled to vote at said election.


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption.


