A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE 2011 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT SUB-RECIPIENT **AGREEMENTS** WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, TEXAS HOMELAND SECURITY STATE ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$331,742.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas, has been awarded funding as part of the 2011 Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$331,742.00; and

WHEREAS, this grant is divided into two parts: (1) the Urban Area Security Initiative Grant, funded at \$291,692.00 which will allow the City of Mesquite Information Technology Department to procure equipment that will be used to establish a redundant data and network infrastructure for public safety departments and fund one of the Emergency Management Specialist positions in the Office of Emergency Management; and (2) the State Homeland Security Grant Program, funded at \$40,050.00, will fund the procurement of equipment and supplies for the new Fire Department REHAB vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the 2011 Homeland Security Grant Program Sub-Recipient Agreements (Award Numbers: 11-SR 47892-01; 11-SR 47892-02; 11SR 47892-03) with the Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Homeland Security State Administrative Agency in the amount of \$331,742.00.
