## RESOLUTION NO. 17-2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON MAY 12, 2012, FOR THE ELECTION OF CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FOR PLACES 3, 4 AND 5; CALLING A RUNOFF ELECTION TO BE HELD JUNE 23, 2012; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, an election was held on May 12, 2012, in the City of Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for each of the following places: Nos. 3, 4 and 5; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, election officials for that election have made their returns to the City Council in the time and manner provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council, having canvassed said returns, has determined that the total number of votes cast in the election held May 12, 2012, was 3,864 and the results of said election are hereby declared to be as follows:

It appearing that no candidate received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilmember, Place 5, it is necessary to call a runoff election to be held June 23, 2012, for the purpose of determining between <u>Greg Noschese</u> and <u>Brian Hutcheson</u> for the Office of Councilmember, Place 5.

SECTION 2. Early voting by personal appearance for the June 23, 2012, Runoff Election shall be conducted by the Dallas County Elections Administrator, who is hereby appointed clerk of early voting in compliance with Section 271.006 of the Texas Election Code. Early voting will be conducted at Lakeside Activity Center, 101 Holley Park Drive, Mesquite, Texas. Any qualified voter for the Runoff Election may vote early by personal appearance at Lakeside Activity Center and at all locations as designated by the Dallas County Elections Administrator.

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted beginning Monday, June 11, 2012, and continuing through Friday, June 15, 2012, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Saturday, June 16, 2012, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Sunday, June 17, 2012, between 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m., and Monday, June 18, 2012, and Tuesday, June 19, 2012, between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on Friday, June 15, 2012.
