RESOLUTION NO. 28–2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$63,059.36 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR EMERGENCY PERMANENT REPAIRS TO THE 10-INCH-DIAMETER SANITARY SEWER AERIAL CROSSING NEAR CEDAR DRIVE IN PASCHALL PARK; AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO TRI-CON SERVICES, INC., FOR SUCH REPAIRS.

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2012, Utilities Division personnel discovered a 10-inch-diameter aerial sanitary sewer crossing collapsed near Cedar Drive in Paschall Park; and

WHEREAS, the spilled sewage was captured and reintroduced into the sewer line downstream of the collapse by mechanical pumping; and

WHEREAS, the spill was reported to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required and a temporary repair was made; and

WHEREAS, Staff initiated an emergency permanent repair contract since the temporary repairs were not likely to withstand inclement weather; and

WHEREAS, the emergency permanent repairs were made between September 11, 2012, and September 18, 2012; and

WHEREAS, such unforeseen damage requires an immediate expenditure of funds without having competitively bid the repairs in order to protect and preserve the public health and safety of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, such procurement is authorized without competitive bidding by Texas Local Government Code §252.022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the expenditure of \$63,059.36 without competitive bidding for emergency repairs for repairing the 10-inch-diameter aerial sanitary sewer crossing collapsed near Cedar Drive in Paschall Park and payment of funds to Tri-Con Services, Inc., for such repairs is hereby ratified and authorized.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is authorized in taking those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this resolution.
