

RESOLUTION NO. 30-2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE 2012 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT SUB-RECIPIENT AGREEMENTS WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, TEXAS HOMELAND SECURITY STATE ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$145,688.26.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas (the "City"), has been awarded funding as part of the 2012 Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$145,688.26; and

WHEREAS, the grant is divided into two projects: (1) a public safety wireless network project funded at \$88,688.26 which will allow the City Information Technology Department to procure equipment that will enhance the network infrastructure for public safety departments; and (2) continue funding the City jurisdictional planning project at \$57,000 which funds one of the Emergency Management Specialist positions in the Office of Emergency Management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the 2012 Homeland Security Grant Program Sub-Recipient Agreements (Award Numbers: 12-SR 47892-01 and 12-SR 47892-02) with the Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Homeland Security State Administrative Agency in the amount of \$145,688.26.
