

RESOLUTION NO. 33-2013

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE 2013 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT SUB-RECIPIENT AGREEMENTS WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, TEXAS HOMELAND SECURITY STATE ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$147,798.01.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas (the "City"), has been awarded funding as part of the 2013 Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$147,798.01; and

WHEREAS, the grant is divided into two projects: (1) an Information Technology (IT) Department project funded at \$79,406.49 to extend the City's fiber optic loop to the McKenzie Water Tower which is an IT infrastructure upgrade needed for the future public safety radio system; and (2) a law enforcement project funded at \$68,391.52 which will fund equipment for the Mesquite Police Department's Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the 2013 Homeland Security Grant Program Sub-Recipient Agreements (Award Numbers: 13-SR 47892-01 and 13-SR 47892-02) with the Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Homeland Security State Administrative Agency in the amount of \$147,798.01.


