

RESOLUTION NO. 22-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF LONGVIEW TO ESTABLISH A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM BETWEEN THE TWO CITIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite and the City of Longview desire to establish a cooperative purchasing program between each other which will allow each city to purchase goods and services under each other's competitively bid contracts pursuant to V.T.C.A., Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 271; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, V.T.C.A., Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, provides authorization for any local government to contract with one or more local governments to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite is of the opinion that participation in this program will be highly beneficial to the taxpayers of the City of Mesquite through the anticipated savings to be realized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Mesquite and the City of Longview is hereby authorized thereby establishing a cooperative purchasing program for the purchase of goods and services under each other's competitively bid contracts.
