RESOLUTION NO. 41–2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, GRANTING LEAVE OF ABSENCE TO JOHN MONACO, MAYOR.

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Mesquite, Texas, provides remedies for declaring vacancy should a City Council member be absent for three regular consecutive meetings; and

Whereas, Article IV, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Mesquite, Texas, further provides that the remedies for declaring vacancy shall not apply should the City Councilmember have first obtained leave of absence at a regular meeting of the City Council; and

Whereas, John Monaco, Mayor of the City of Mesquite, Texas, has applied to the City Council for leave of absence for a period of 60 days due to health reasons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That John Monaco, Mayor of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby granted leave of absence for health reasons for a period of 60 days from the date of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. That during the term of the leave of absence hereby granted, John Monaco, Mayor of the City of Mesquite, Texas, shall be, and is, excused from the consecutive meeting requirements of Article IV, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Mesquite, Texas.

SECTION 3. That the leave of absence herein granted shall continue until the first to occur of the expiration of 60 days from the date of this Resolution, or Mayor John Monaco advising the City Council that his health concerns no longer prevent him from fulfilling his duties as Mayor of the City of Mesquite, Texas.
