

RESOLUTION NO. 19-2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$147,511.60 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY TO REPAIR THE 12-INCH-DIAMETER SANITARY SEWER AERIAL CROSSING ON SOUTH MESQUITE CREEK (NORTH OF FAITHON P. LUCAS, SENIOR BOULEVARD); AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO TRI-CON SERVICES, INC., FOR SUCH REPAIRS.

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2014, it was discovered that a large diameter (12-inch) sanitary sewer aerial crossing serving the Hills of Tealwood, Phase 1 Addition had collapsed; and

WHEREAS, a large tree undermined by creek bank erosion fell on the main crushing the pier; and

WHEREAS, City crews mobilized to the site and installed a temporary main across the creek; and

WHEREAS, delays in obtaining the materials necessary for replacement of the aerial crossing as well as the heavy rains prevented the repair work to begin until early February 2015; and

WHEREAS, the permanent repairs were completed on February 20, 2015; and

WHEREAS, such an expenditure of funds was necessary in order to protect and preserve the public health and safety of the residents of the City; and


WHEREAS, such procurement is authorized without competitive bidding by Texas Local Government Code §252.022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the expenditure of \$147,511.60 without competitive bidding for repairing the 12-inch-diameter sanitary sewer aerial crossing on South Mesquite Creek (north of Faithon P. Lucas, Senior Boulevard) and payment of funds to Tri-Con Services, Inc. was necessary to preserve and protect the public health of the City's residents and such expenditure is hereby ratified and authorized.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is authorized in taking those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this resolution.
