

RESOLUTION NO. 25-2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON MAY 9, 2015, FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR AND CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FOR PLACES 1, 2 AND 6; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the annual City Election was held on May 9, 2015, in the City of Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Councilmembers for each of the following places: Nos. 1, 2 and 6, for two (2) year terms; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, election officials for that election have made their returns to the City Council in the time and manner provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council, having canvassed said returns, has determined that the total number of votes cast in the election held May 9, 2015, was 5,286 and the results of said election are hereby declared to be as follows:



It appearing that Jeff Casper received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilmember, Place 2; therefore, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying for a term of two (2) years, commencing May 2015, and until a successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that Dennis Tarpley received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilmember, Place 6; therefore, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying for a term of two (2) years, commencing May 2015, and until a successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.
