RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF NOVEMBER 3, 2015 BOND ELECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND CONTAINING PROVISIONS NECESSARY AND INCIDENTAL THERETO

WHEREAS, this City Council duly authorized an election to be held within the City of Mesquite, Texas (the "City") on November 3, 2015 (the "Election"), for the purpose of submitting to the resident qualified electors of the City the proposition hereinafter set forth;
