RESOLUTION NO. 14-2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ADOPTING A POLICY PROHIBITING THE CARRYING OF WEAPONS, INCLUDING HANDGUNS AND OTHER FIREARMS, INTO ANY MEETING OF A GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT; PROVIDING AN EXCEPTION FOR LICENSED PEACE OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, in the 84th Legislative Session, the Legislature adopted new regulations related to open and concealed, licensed handgun carry; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite desires to comply with state law and properly implement these new regulations as they interface with many existing weapon and firearm regulations; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 46.035(c) of the Texas Penal Code, concealed or open carrying of a handgun is prohibited if the license holder is given notice, pursuant to Sections 30.06 and 30.07 of the Texas Penal Code, that carrying is prohibited into any meeting of a governmental entity subject to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code (Texas Open Meetings Act).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, hereby adopts a policy prohibiting the carrying of weapons, including handguns and other firearms, into any meeting of a governmental entity that is subject to the Texas Open Meetings Act to read as follows:

Possession of Weapons Restricted at Open Meetings.

- A. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, hereby adopts a policy prohibiting a person, except a licensed peace officer, from carrying a weapon including, without limitation, a concealed and open carry handgun and other firearms, into a room or rooms where the City is holding a meeting that is subject to the Texas Open Meetings Act.
- В. For purposes of this policy, a weapon includes prohibited weapons defined by Section 46.05 of the Texas Penal Code and firearms, clubs and illegal knives as defined by Section 46.01 of the Texas Penal Code.
