

RESOLUTION NO. 47-2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THE MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO DETERMINE WHICH CONTRACTING METHOD UNDER CHAPTER 2269 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE PROVIDES THE BEST VALUE FOR THE CITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF CONSTRUCTION SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2269, "Contracting and Delivery Procedure for Construction Projects," of the Texas Government Code, as amended (the "Chapter"), authorizes the use of alternate contracting and delivery methods by governmental entities for construction projects; and

WHEREAS, the Chapter provides that, before advertising, the governing body of the governmental entity that considers a construction contracting method, other than competitive bidding, must first determine which method provides the best value for the governmental entity; and


WHEREAS, the Chapter also authorizes the governing body of a governmental entity to delegate its authority under the Chapter regarding an action authorized or required by the Chapter to a designated representative.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite authorizes the City Manager, or the Manager's designee, to determine which contracting method and delivery procedure provided for under Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code, as amended, shall provide the best value for the City for the purchase of construction services.


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.


