

RESOLUTION NO. 50-2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE CITY OF MESQUITE'S APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S 2019 SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL-INFRASTRUCTURE CALL FOR PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") issued a call for projects in February 2019 for communities to apply for funding assistance through TxDOT's Safe Routes to School-Infrastructure ("SRTS") Programs; and

WHEREAS, the SRTS funds may be used for development of plans, specifications and estimates, environmental documentation, and construction of pedestrian and/or bicycle infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the SRTS funds do not require a local match; and


WHEREAS, as the Project Sponsor, the City of Mesquite (the "City") would be responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100 percent of overruns, if any, for the SRTS funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council supports funding the Mesquite Cartwright Safe Routes to School project, as described in the City's 2019 SRTS Detailed Application (including the construction budget and TxDOT's administrative cost), and is willing to commit to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management and financing.


SECTION 2. The City Council will authorize the City Manager by resolution to enter into an agreement with TxDOT should the project be selected for funding.
