

RESOLUTION NO. 55-2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ORDERING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 5, 2019, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS FOR PLACES 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 AND 6.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Mesquite requires the regular municipal election for the City to be held on the uniform election date provided by the general election laws of the State of Texas in odd-numbered years; and

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code § 41.001(a) provides a general election of city officials may be held the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City Council of the City of Mesquite order an election to be held November 5, 2019, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Councilmembers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. A general election shall be held in the City of Mesquite on November 5, 2019. At the election, there shall be elected by the qualified voters of the City a Mayor (at large) and City Councilmembers (single member districts) for Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6. The candidates for Mayor shall meet all requirements and shall be residents of the City of Mesquite. The Mayor shall be elected by majority vote of the City at large. The candidates for Councilmember Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall meet all requirements and shall be residents of their respective Districts, being Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, and shall be elected by majority vote of voters residing in each respective district.

SECTION 2. Notice of such election shall be published at least once not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day before election day as provided in § 4.003(a)(1) of the Texas Election Code.

SECTION 3. Said election shall be held in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Texas, the Statutes of the State of Texas, and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Mesquite, and shall be in conformity with the procedures set forth herein.

SECTION 4. Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted by the Dallas County Elections Department and Kaufman County Elections Department.

Toni Pippins-Poole, Dallas County Elections Administrator, Dallas County, and Brenda Samples, Tax Assessor/Collector, Kaufman County, are hereby appointed clerks of early voting in compliance with Section 271.006 of the Texas Election Code.

Any qualified voter for the election may vote early by personal appearance at either the main early voting location or at any of the branch locations.



If an application for ballot by mail (“ABBM”) is faxed or emailed or if a Federal Postcard Application (“FPCA”) is faxed, the early voting clerk must receive the original ABBM or FPCA no later than the 4th business day after receiving the emailed or faxed ABBM or faxed FPCA. If such original ABBM or FPCA is not received by the early voting clerk by the deadline, the faxed or emailed ABBM or faxed FPCA will be considered incomplete and the early voting clerk may NOT send the applicant a ballot. The requirement to mail the original application does not apply to an emailed FPCA. An ABBM must be received by Noon or close of business, whichever is later, on Friday, October 25, 2019. An FPCA must be received in accordance with V.T.C.A., Election Code, § 101.052.

SECTION 5. Should any candidate running for Mayor or Councilmember fail to receive a majority vote of all votes cast for that office in said election, then in that event, it shall be the duty of the Mayor to order a second election for the candidate or candidates failing to receive a majority vote, said election to be held in accordance with State law.


SECTION 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
