

RESOLUTION NO. 41-2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FINALIZE AND EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO DESIGNATE THE POSITIONS OF DIRECTOR OF FINANCE, MANAGER OF ACCOUNTING, AND MANAGER OF BUDGET AND TREASURY TO ACT AS THE CITY OF MESQUITE'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES FOR TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT INVESTMENT POOL ("TEXPOOL/TEXPOOL PRIME").

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas (the "**City**"), is a local government of the State of Texas and, pursuant to Chapter 2256 of the Texas Government Code, the Public Funds Investment Act ("**PFIA**"), is empowered to delegate to the public funds investment pool the authority to invest funds and to act as custodian of investments purchased with local investment funds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to invest local funds in investments that provide for the preservation and safety of principal, liquidity, and yield consistent with the PFIA; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Investment Pool ("**TexPool/TexPool Prime**"), a public funds investment pool, was created on behalf of entities whose investment objectives in order of priority are preservation and safety of principal, liquidity, and yield consistent with the PFIA; and

WHEREAS, the City invests local funds with and through TexPool/TexPool Prime; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2017, the City Council approved Resolution No. 44-2017 that designated authorized representatives to act on the City's behalf in connection with investments made with and through TexPool/TexPool Prime and further authorized participation in TexPool Prime; and

WHEREAS, due to a change in personnel for the position of Director of Finance and a title change from Manager of Budget and Financial Analysis to Manager of Budget and Treasury for the City, TexPool/TexPool Prime requested the City provide a Resolution Amending Authorized Representatives designating and identifying the persons and positions authorized to act on the City's behalf, and that said Resolution be in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Resolution Amending Authorized Representatives, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, is hereby approved and the Mayor authorized to finalize and execute said Resolution.

SECTION 2. That the positions and persons identified in the Resolution Amending Authorized Representatives are authorized representatives of the City and are each hereby authorized to undertake the actions authorized for them in the attached Resolution.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution amends and supersedes Resolution No. 44-2017 only so far as this Resolution conflicts with Resolution No. 44-2017, which otherwise remains valid and operative.

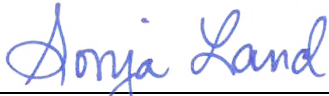

("Participant") is a local government of the State of Texas and is empowered to delegate to a public funds investment pool the authority to invest funds and to act as custodian of investments purchased with local investment funds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Participant to invest local funds in investments that provide for the preservation and safety of principal, liquidity, and yield consistent with the Public Funds Investment Act; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Investment Pool ("TexPool / Texpool Prime"), a public funds investment pool, were created on behalf of entities whose investment objective in order of priority are preservation and safety of principal, liquidity, and yield consistent with the Public Funds Investment Act.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

- A. That the individuals, whose signatures appear in this Resolution, are Authorized Representatives of the Participant and are each hereby authorized to transmit funds for investment in TexPool / TexPool Prime and are each further authorized to withdraw funds from time to time, to issue letters of instruction, and to take all other actions deemed necessary or appropriate for the investment of local funds.
- B. That an Authorized Representative of the Participant may be deleted by a written instrument signed by two remaining Authorized Representatives provided that the deleted Authorized Representative (1) is assigned job duties that no longer require access to the Participant's TexPool / TexPool Prime account or (2) is no longer employed by the Participant; and
- C. That the Participant may by Amending Resolution signed by the Participant add an Authorized Representative provided the additional Authorized Representative is an officer, employee, or agent of the Participant;

List the Authorized Representative(s) of the Participant. Any new individuals will be issued personal identification numbers to transact business with TexPool Participant Services.

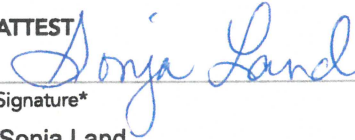
