

RESOLUTION NO. 32-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE HAZARD MITIGATION ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas (the “City”), recognizes the threat that hazards pose to people and property within the geographical boundaries and surrounding areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the City Hazard Mitigation Action Plan (“Plan”) identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted public hearings and afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input on the Plan and the actions in the Plan; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Plan and affirms that the Plan will be updated no less than every five years; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Division of Emergency Management (“TDEM”) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) have reviewed and approved the Plan pending City Council adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Mesquite Hazard Mitigation Action Plan is hereby adopted, a copy of which shall be maintained in the City Secretary’s office as an original document.
