

RESOLUTION NO. 43-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER AND REALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROGRAM YEAR 2021-2022 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AND FILING AN APPLICATION FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,135,680.00 FOR FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT; APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE PROGRAM YEAR 2021-2022 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN; AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF GIVING REQUIRED ASSURANCES AND ACTING IN CONNECTION WITH SAID APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, there is a total of funding requests for the Community Development Block Grant (“**CDBG**”) Program Year 2021-2022 (“**PY 2021-22**”) in the amount of \$1,635,613.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite (“**City**”) is entitled to an amount not to exceed \$1,135,680.00 in the PY 2021-22 CDBG Funds under the Housing and Community Development Act; and

WHEREAS, with proper authorization, an amount not exceeding \$132,189.72 may be transferred from the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (“**NSP**”) Income to the PY 2021-22 CDBG Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, there are also funds in the sum of \$66,311.14 available in the CDBG Program Year 2019-2020 fund that can be reallocated to the PY 2021-22 CDBG Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed PY 2021-22 CDBG Action Plan Budget and Activities is outlined in the attached Exhibit A, which includes the transfer and reallocation of the foregoing funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted public hearings

and the City Council considered the suggestions and recommendations that were raised at the hearings for the expenditure of the funds in the PY 2021-22 CDBG Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it is in the public interest of the citizens of Mesquite that the foregoing transfer and reallocation of funds be made, that application be made for the PY 2021-22 CDBG Funds be made and that the PY 2021-22 CDBG Annual Action Plan be adopted.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or his designee to take all actions necessary to accomplish a transfer of funds not to exceed \$132,189.72 from the NSP Income to the PY 2021-22 CDBG Annual Action Plan and the reallocation of \$66,311.14 available in the Community Development Block Grant Program Year 2019-2020 to the PY 2021-22 CDBG Annual Action Plan; and

SECTION 2. That the PY 2021-22 CDBG Program Allocation, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved and adopted by the City as its PY 2021-22 CDBG Annual Action Plan.



That the City Manager is hereby authorized to file an application for funds under the Housing and Community Development Act on behalf of the City, and to certify all understandings and assurances required under Federal Management Circular 74-4, National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, Titles VI and VII of the Civil Rights Acts of 1964 and 1968 respectively, Executive Orders 11063 and 11246 and such other assurances as may be required to carry out the actions authorized by this Ordinance.
