A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, OF NO OBJECTION FOR PALLADIUM BRUTON ROAD, LTD.'S APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS (THE "TDHCA") FOR 2024 NON-COMPETITIVE 4% HOUSING TAX CREDITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN APPROXIMATELY 288-UNIT AFFORDABLE MULTIFAMILY RENTAL HOUSING DEVELOPMENT TO BE LOCATED AT 2255 WEST BRUTON ROAD; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY SECRETARY TO CERTIFY THE RESOLUTION TO THE TDHCA.
