RESOLUTION NO. <u>03-2025</u>

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AND SUBMIT APPLICATIONS WITH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION, AN OPERATING ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED BY 49 U.S.C. CHAPTER 53, TITLE 23, UNITED STATES CODE, AND OTHER FEDERAL STATUTES ADMINISTERED BY THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, the Federal Transportation Administrator has been delegated authority to award federal financial assistance for a transportation project; and

WHEREAS, the grant or cooperative agreement for such federal financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the Applicant, and may require the Applicant to provide the local share of the project cost; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has or will provide all annual certifications and assurances to the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") required for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or his or her designee (the "City Manager") is authorized to execute and file applications for federal assistance on behalf of the City of Mesquite, Texas (the "City"), with the FTA for federal assistance authorized by 49 U.S.C., Chapter 53, Title 23, United States Code, or other federal statutes authorizing a project administered by the FTA. The City is informed it is a Designated Recipient of the 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Program as defined by 49 U.S.C., § 5307(a)(2). In the event any such federal assistance may require the City to provide a local share of any project cost, then the City Manager shall take steps necessary to budget funds for such local share and provide such funds as required by the governing statutes, rules, regulations, and agreements.

- SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute and file with the City's applications the annual certifications and assurances and other documents the FTA requires before awarding a federal assistance grant or cooperative agreement.
- SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute grant and cooperative agreements with the FTA on behalf of the City of Mesquite, Texas.
