## RESOLUTION NO. <u>16-2025</u>

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ENDORSING AND ACCEPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION AUTHORITY AUXILIARY GRANT AWARD OF \$20,833.00 FOR THE LEASE OR PURCHASE OF AN AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE READER INVESTIGATIONS SOFTWARE AND \$8,667.00 FOR THE LEASE OR PURCHASE OF AN ALPR CAMERA; APPROVING THE CONTRIBUTION OF CITY FUNDS WITH A 20 PERCENT MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,167.00 FOR THE ALPR INVESTIGATION SOFTWARE AND \$1,733.00 FOR THE ALPR CAMERA; DESIGNATING AND AUTHORIZING OFFICIALS TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, REJECT, ALTER, TERMINATE, AND **OTHERWISE** ADMINISTER THE GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND AGREEING TO RETURN THE GRANT IN THE EVENT OF LOSS OR MISUSE OF THE GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43, Part 3, Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority ("MVCPA") to provide financial support to law enforcement agencies for economic motor vehicle theft enforcement teams; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas (the "City"), submitted a grant application for the lease or purchase of an automatic license plate reader ("ALPR") investigations software and an ALPR camera to combat motor vehicle theft, motor vehicle burglary, and fraud-related motor vehicle crime: and

WHEREAS, the lease or purchase of an ALPR investigations software will be funded in part by MVCPA for \$20,833.00 and part by City funds in the amount of \$4,167.00 and for the grant term from September 1, 2025, through August 31, 2026 (the "Grant Funded Period"); and

WHEREAS, the lease or purchase of an ALPR camera will be funded in part by MVCPA for \$8,667.00 and in part by City funds totaling \$1,733.00 for the Grant Funded Period; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to the lease of an ALPR investigations software and ALPR camera for one additional year beyond the Grant Funded Period should the City lease an ALPR investigations software and ALPR camera with MVCPA grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to return the grant funds in full to MVCPA in the case of loss or misuse of the grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The City Council hereby endorses and accepts the Fiscal Year 2026 MVCPA Auxiliary Grant Award of \$20,833.00 and approves the contribution of City funds in the amount of \$4,167.00 for the ALPR investigations software.

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SECTION 2. The City Council hereby endorses and accepts the Fiscal Year 2026 MVCPA Auxiliary Grant Award of \$8,667.00 and approves the contribution of City funds of \$1,733.00 for the ALPR camera.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. The following individuals are authorized to perform the following concerning the MVCPA Grant Program:

- A. The City Manager is designated as the "Authorized Official" to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the MVCPA Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant.
- B. The Property Crimes Sergeant in the Mesquite Police Department is designated as the "**Program Director**" for the grant and is responsible for all day-to-day grant operations. The Project Director is responsible for all programmatic reporting, grant maintenance, and ensuring that purchasing procedures align with audit compliance.
- C. The Grants Finance Administrator is designated as the "Financial Officer" for this grant and is responsible for the maintenance of all financial records related to the grant funding. The Financial Officer is responsible for requesting funds and completing quarterly financial reporting in the grant management system.

SECTION 4. The City agrees to return the grant funds in full to MVCPA in the event of loss or misuse.
