- I. The following guidelines will be followed when patrol personnel are dispatched to transport prisoners from local jail facilities to the Mesquite Jail.
 - A. A patrol unit will transport no more than two prisoners per trip. If more than two prisoners need to be transported from a location, a second unit will be sent.
 - B. Patrol personnel will not be dispatched to more than one location to pick up prisoners. If prisoners need to be transported from more than one location, a separate patrol unit will be dispatched to each location.
 - C. Patrol personnel, when being dispatched to a prisoner transport call, will be given the name and date of birth of the individual(s) to be transported. The patrol officer will write down the name and date of birth of the individual(s) and ensure that he/she is the same subject whom they actually transport.
