All new interior carpeting shall be continuous filament nylon with performance rating of 5.0 or better, FHA approved, 5 year minimum wear warranty. As manufactured by L.D. Brinkman, Alladin or approved equivalent with an installed price, including 3/8" re-bond pad, of \$17.00 yard, excluding profit and overhead.

Add Item #49:

DRYWALL

Remove and dispose of all existing drywall to a code approved waste/recycling facility. Hang, tape and 3 coat finish 3/8" drywall. Screw or nail 8" on center. Run boards with long dimension horizontal. Sand ready for paint.
