The City of Mesquite, Texas invites sealed proposals from all qualified vendors desiring to furnish the City with the Annual Preventative Maintenance Services of Light-Duty City Vehicles, complying with the following specifications as listed herein.

Mark envelope in lower left corner "RFP No. 2023-041; Annual Preventative Maintenance Services of Light-Duty City Vehicles", so that the proposals will not be opened until the appointed hour. Proposals submitted must be received before proposal closing on Thursday, January 5, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. Faxed or emailed proposals **will not** be accepted.

GENERAL CLAUSES AND CONDITIONS

1. If you have questions regarding the preparation of your proposal, you may contact purchasing@cityofmesquite.com.
2. Vendors who do not respond to this particular proposal, but who want to remain on our mailing list for future opportunities shall indicate "NO PROPOSAL" on the face of this page by putting the date and signed by the authorized representative of your company and return this page to the Purchasing office. Your assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated.
3. **Protection of Resident Workers:** The City of Mesquite actively supports the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), which includes provisions addressing employment eligibility, employment verification, and nondiscrimination. Under the INA, employers may hire only persons who may legally work in the United States (i.e., citizens and nationals of the U.S.) and aliens authorized to work in the U.S. The employer must verify the identity and employment eligibility of anyone to be hired, which includes completing the Employment Eligibility Verification Form (I-9). The Contractor shall establish appropriate procedures and controls so no services or products under the Contract Documents will be performed or manufactured by any worker who is not legally eligible to perform such services or employment.
4. **Laws and Ordinances:** The Contractor shall at all times observe and comply with all Federal, State and local laws, ordinances and regulations which in any manner affect the Contract or the work and shall

indemnify and save harmless the City against any claim arising from the violation of any such laws, ordinances and regulations whether by the Contractor or his employees.

5. Proposals must be **received as one (1) original plus one (1) digital copy on a USB flash drive** prior to the closing date and time to be considered. Proposals must be submitted in sufficient time to be received and time-stamped at the above location on or before the published date and time shown on the RFP. The City of Mesquite will not be responsible for mail delivered from the post office. Proposals received after the published time and date cannot be considered and will be returned unopened.
6. Proposals will be received but not publicly acknowledged at the location, date and time stated above. All proposers will be notified 2-3 days after the opening date via email. Other information submitted by the proposers shall not be released by the City during the proposal evaluation process or prior to contract award. At no time will confidential information, as noted by the proposer, be released.
7. Proposer shall attach official documentation from the State of Texas or other qualified certification agency of M/WBE status of your company with proposal. This data is for informational purposes only and will not affect the proposal award.
8. A completed W-9 form will be required and submitted with proposal.
9. In submitting an offer, respondent certifies that they have not participated in, nor have they been party to any collusion, price fixing or any other illegal or unethical agreements with any company, firm or person concerning the pricing offered.
10. The attached Non-Exclusion Affidavit for General Contractors must be signed, notarized and submitted with proposal.
11. A representative of the proposing entity who is authorized to enter into contract on behalf of the proposing entity must manually sign proposals in ink. The person signing the proposal must indicate his/her title along with signature. Proposals received without proper signature will not be considered.
12. Any ambiguity in the proposal as a result of omission, error, lack of clarity or non-compliance by the proposer with specifications, instructions and all conditions shall be construed in favor of the City.
13. The City of Mesquite reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, waive formalities and to make award of proposal as may be deemed to the best advantage of the City. No proposal may be withdrawn within forty-five (45) days after date of opening.
14. The Contract may be terminated at any time with thirty-(30) day's written notice by either the City of Mesquite or successful proposer.
15. The City is not liable for any cost incurred by Proposers in replying to this RFP. This includes costs to determine the nature of the proposal, submitting, negotiating, presentations or any other costs a vendor would incur in responding to the RFP.
16. Proposers shall complete all information requested and blanks provided shall be filled in on the provided forms. Failure to completely describe the merchandise being proposed may result in rejection of your proposal.

17. **The City is exempt from all sales and excise taxes.**
18. The City of Mesquite reserves the right to evaluate variations from these specifications. If exceptions are made, proposer shall state wherein the merchandise fails to meet these specifications. Failure to completely describe the merchandise being proposed may result in rejection of your proposal.
19. It shall be understood all proposals, responses, inquiries or correspondence relating to or in reference to this RFP, and all reports, charges and proposal or referencing information submitted in response to this RFP shall become the property of the City and will not be returned. All restrictions on the use of data contained within a proposal and all confidential information must be clearly stated in the RFP. Proprietary information submitted in a proposal, or in response to the RFP, will be handled in accordance with the Texas Open Records Law and other applicable state statutes.
20. It is the vendor's responsibility to check for any addendums that might have been issued before the proposal closing date and time.
21. Cooperative Purchasing: As permitted under the Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 791025, other *government entities may wish to also participate under the same terms and conditions contained in this contract (piggyback)*. Each entity wishing to piggyback must have prior authorization from the City of Mesquite and vendor. If such participation is authorized, all purchase orders will be issued directly from and shipped directly to the entity requiring supplies/services. The City of Mesquite shall not be held responsible for any orders placed, deliveries made or payment for supplies/services ordered by these entities. Each entity reserves the right to determine their participation in this contract.

Successful proposer agrees to extend prices to all entities that have entered into or will enter into joint purchasing interlocal cooperation agreements with the City of Mesquite _____ Yes _____ No.

22. The proposal evaluation process will occur after the closing date. The City's evaluation and clarification process will commence. An evaluation team will review the proposals. Financial terms will not be the sole determining factor in this award. Other criteria described in this RFP will be considered, as well as any other factors the evaluation team determines may affect the suitability of the proposal for the City's requirements. A Proposer's submission of a proposal constitutes their acceptance of the evaluation technique.
23. Price quoted shall prevail for the entire term of the contract; one (1) year starting after proposal is awarded by City Council to the successful proposer. A renewal option is included as a part of this proposal for an additional four (4) one-year periods, renewable on anniversary of the original date, provided proposer can maintain proposal prices and both parties are in mutual agreement.
24. The insurance requirements are included in the proposal document. Proposers agree to provide and to maintain the required types of insurance for the term of the contract. An original certificate of insurance will be required within 10 business days by the apparent low proposer once notification has been received.
25. The sample Contract form is included for proposer's information so that proposers may be familiar with their contents and requirements. **Proposer shall not fill in or execute these forms at time of proposal submittal. Upon award of the proposal, the awarded vendor will be required to execute the contract.**

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. **Price escalation:** The City of Mesquite favors fixed pricing. However, due to market conditions, which may result in an increase in the costs of materials awarded by this contract during the contract term, the City may consider, at its option, a request by the successful proposer for a price escalation equivalent to the percentage increase of materials. Price escalation will be made under the following conditions: 1) no request for a price escalation will be considered for the first year of the contract period; 2) Contractor will be required to provide written confirmation from his supplier indicating the exact percentage of increase as well as the effective date of the escalation; 3) The City reserves the right to accept or reject the price increase; and 4) If the price increase is rejected, the Contractor shall provide the materials at the contracted price or may cancel the contract for the remaining term.
2. The successful proposer's rights and duties awarded by the contract may not be assigned to another without written consent of the City signed by the City's authorized agent. Such consent shall not relieve the assigned of liability in the event of default by the assignee.
3. Any deviations from specifications and alternate proposals must be clearly shown with complete information provided by the proposer. They may or may not be considered by the City.
4. No oral statement of any person shall modify or otherwise change, or affect the terms, conditions or specifications stated in the resulting contract. All change orders to the contract will be made in writing and shall not be effective unless signed by an authorized representative of the City.
5. The City shall have the right to modify this order subject to an adjustment in the price in accordance with the applicable provisions of the purchase order, if any, or pursuant to mutual agreements. No agreement or understanding to modify this order shall be binding on the City unless it is in writing and signed by an authorized representative of the City.
6. The City reserves the right to require additional technical and pricing information and negotiate all elements, which comprise the Vendor's proposal to ensure that the best possible consideration be afforded to all concerned. The City reserves the right to accept all or part of any proposal, to reject any or all proposals and to re-solicit for proposals.
7. All questions must be submitted via email at purchasing@cityofmesquite.com by 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 29, 2022, prior to proposal closing date.
8. Proposers shall submit a total of five (5) references.

Chapter 176 of the Texas Local Government Code is an ethics law that was initially enacted by the Texas Legislature with HB 914 in 2005 that requires disclosure of employment and business relationships local government officers may have with contractors, consultants and vendors who conduct business with local government entities. The law applies to any written contract for the sale or purchase of real property, goods or services. CONFLICT OF INTEREST QUESTIONNAIRE
For vendor doing business with local governmental entity

A complete copy of Chapter 176 of the Local Government Code may be found at <http://www.statutes.legis.state.tx.us/Docs/LG/htm/LG.176.htm>. For easy reference, below are some of the sections cited on this form.

Local Government Code § 176.001(1-a): "Business relationship" means a connection between two or more parties based on commercial activity of one of the parties. The term does not include a connection based on:

- (A) a transaction that is subject to rate or fee regulation by a federal, state, or local governmental entity or an agency of a federal, state, or local governmental entity;
- (B) a transaction conducted at a price and subject to terms available to the public; or
- (C) a purchase or lease of goods or services from a person that is chartered by a state or federal agency and that is subject to regular examination by, and reporting to, that agency.

Local Government Code § 176.003(a)(2)(A) and (B):

(a) A local government officer shall file a conflicts disclosure statement with respect to a vendor if:

(2) the vendor:

(A) has an employment or other business relationship with the local government officer or a family member of the officer that results in the officer or family member receiving taxable income, other than investment income, that exceeds \$2,500 during the 12-month period preceding the date that the officer becomes aware that

(i) a contract between the local governmental entity and vendor has been executed;

or

(ii) the local governmental entity is considering entering into a contract with the vendor;

(B) has given to the local government officer or a family member of the officer one or more gifts that have an aggregate value of more than \$100 in the 12-month period preceding the date the officer becomes aware that:

(i) a contract between the local governmental entity and vendor has been executed; or

(ii) the local governmental entity is considering entering into a contract with the vendor.

Local Government Code § 176.006(a) and (a-1)

(a) A vendor shall file a completed conflict of interest questionnaire if the vendor has a business relationship with a local governmental entity and:

(1) has an employment or other business relationship with a local government officer of that local governmental entity, or a family member of the officer, described by Section 176.003(a)(2)(A);

(2) has given a local government officer of that local governmental entity, or a family member of the officer, one or more gifts with the aggregate value specified by Section 176.003(a)(2)(B), excluding any gift described by Section 176.003(a-1); or

(3) has a family relationship with a local government officer of that local governmental entity.

(a-1) The completed conflict of interest questionnaire must be filed with the appropriate records administrator not later than the seventh business day after the later of:

(1) the date that the vendor:

(A) begins discussions or negotiations to enter into a contract with the local governmental entity; or

(B) submits to the local governmental entity an application, response to a request for proposals or bids, correspondence, or another writing related to a potential contract with the local governmental entity; or

(2) the date the vendor becomes aware:

(A) of an employment or other business relationship with a local government officer, or a family member of the officer, described by Subsection (a);

(B) that the vendor has given one or more gifts described by Subsection (a); or

(C) of a family relationship with a local government officer.

Standards of Conduct

The City of Mesquite conducts business with the public, business partners, vendors and contractors under a set of rules to ensure that all City officials and employees discharge their duties in a manner designed to promote public trust and confidence in our city. This code of ethics, titled Standards of Conduct, is taken from the Mesquite City Code, Chapter 2, Art. IV, Sec 2-123.

The City wants you to be aware of the rules that its employees are required to follow while performing their services to you. A violation of state or federal statutes may occur if these rules are broken. It is hoped that by outlining these rules for you, your experience in dealing with the City of Mesquite will be both rewarding and satisfactory.

Acceptance of Gifts or Gratuities

Accepting gifts or gratuities by employees in consideration for the performance of their duties, or as an appreciation for their performance, is strictly prohibited.

- Please do not offer employees any gift, loans or any other thing of value.
- Employees may not receive any fee or compensation for their services from any source other than the City, so please do not offer.
- Please do not offer to buy meals for employees.
- Employees may accept coffee, tea, soft drinks, snacks, etc. when attending meetings in your office.
- Letters to supervisors for exceptional service by employees are always welcome.

Conflicts of Interest

Employees are prohibited from engaging in any outside activities that conflict with, or have the appearance of conflicting with, the duties assigned to them in the employment of the City.

- Please do not ask employees for any special favor or consideration that is not available to every other citizen.
- Please do not ask an employee to disclose any information that is not available to every other citizen through normal public information channels.
- Please do not offer to compensate the employee by offering to hire, or do business with any business entity of the employee or family member
- Do not ask employees to represent you or your company or make any recommendations on your behalf other than those that are a part of their official duties with the City.
- Please do not ask employees to endorse the products or services of your company.
- Please do not ask employees to hand out or post advertising materials.

Solicitation by City Employees

Employees may not solicit gifts, loans, or any other items of value from people doing City business that will be used by them personally.

- If you are asked to pay a fee for services that you believe is improper or illegal, please contact the City's ethic's officer at **972-329-8723**. (payments should only be made to designated cashiers or clerks)
- Employees are prohibited from taking retaliatory action against you for failing to comply with any request unless the request is within the scope of the employee's official duties for the City.

Use of City Equipment, Facilities and Resources

Use of City equipment, facilities and resources is authorized only for City purposes and for those activities permitted by City ordinance and policy.

- Please do not ask employees to use City equipment to run errands or perform tasks for your benefit.
- Employees may not perform tasks, nor conduct any business not related to their official duties while on City time.

Your Rights and Expectations

When dealing with employees of the City of Mesquite you have the right to honest, fair and impartial treatment. You may expect prompt, courteous and professional service from our employees who are expected to understand and practice good customer service skills. Employees are tasked to uphold the public trust through the ethical performance of their duties. We understand that the enforcement of regulatory guidelines and codes may sometimes be a cause for concern; however, you may rest assured that we are responsible to all of the citizens of Mesquite and our goal is to serve them to the best of our ability.

INSURANCE

A. AMOUNTS OF INSURANCE

Contractor agrees to provide and to maintain the following types and amounts of insurance, for the term of this Contract.

3. <u>Business (Commercial)</u> <u>Automobile Policy:</u>	Combined Single Limit/ \$500,000

The preceding amounts notwithstanding, the City reserves the right to increase the minimum required insurance to be effective thirty (30) days after notice is sent to the address provided herein. The Contractor may pass through to the City all costs for obtaining the increase in the insurance coverage.

B. OTHER INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor understands that it is its sole responsibility to provide the required Certificate and that failure to comply within 10 business days after notice of award and according to the requirements of this article shall be a cause for termination of this Contract.

For any pesticide spraying performed, the City of Mesquite will require the successful bidder to carry Pollution Liability Insurance and Environmental Impairment Liability Insurance.

Insurance required herein shall be issued by a company or companies of sound and adequate financial responsibility and authorized to do business in the State of Texas. All policies shall be subject to examination and approval by the City Attorney's office for their adequacy as to form, content, form of protection, and providing company.

Insurance required by this Contract for the City, as additional insured shall be primary insurance and not contributing with any other insurance available to City, under any third party liability policy.

The Contractor further agrees that with respect to the above required insurances, the City shall:

1. Be named as additional insured/or an insured, on all required insurance except workers'

compensation. Blanket Endorsements are acceptable in meeting this requirement if copies of the endorsements are provided along with the certificate. If using a form that has specific boxes labeled for additional insured, checking those specific boxes is acceptable in meeting this requirement as well.

2. Be provided with a waiver of subrogation, in favor of the City on all required insurance. Blanket Endorsements are acceptable in meeting this requirement if copies of the endorsements are provided along with the certificate. If using a form that has specific boxes labeled for waiver of subrogation, checking those specific boxes is acceptable in meeting this requirement as well.
3. Be provided with an unconditional 30 days' advance written notice of cancellation or material change.
4. Prior to execution of this Agreement, proof of insurance shall be provided through the office of the City Secretary, or Designee, with either their original Certificate of Insurance or their insurance policy evidencing the above requirements. Thereafter, new certificates or copies of the policies shall be furnished prior to the expiration date of any prior certificate.

C. ADDITIONAL WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Definitions:
Certificate of coverage ("certificate") A copy of a certificate of insurance, a certificate of authority to self-insure issued by the commission, or a coverage agreement showing statutory Worker's Compensation insurance coverage for the person's or entity's employees providing services on a project, for the duration of the project.

Duration of the project - includes the time from the beginning of the work on the project until the contractors'/person's work on the project has been completed and accepted by the governmental entity.

Persons providing services on the project (subcontractor" in 406.096) - includes all persons or entitles performing all or part of the services the contractor has undertaken to perform on the project, regardless of whether that person contracted directly with the contractor and regardless of whether that person has employees. This includes, without limitation, independent contractors, subcontractors, leasing companies, motor carriers, owner-operators, employees of any such entity or employees of any entity, which furnishes persons to provide services on the project. "Services" include, without limitation, providing, hauling, or other service related to a project. "Services" does not include activities unrelated to the project, such as food/beverage vendors, office supply deliveries, and delivery of portable toilets.

2. The contractor shall provide coverage, based on proper reporting of classification codes and payroll amounts and filing of any coverage agreements. Which meets the statutory requirements of Texas Labor Code, Section 401.011 (44) for all employees of the contractor providing services on the project, for the duration of the project.
3. The Contractor must provide a certificate of coverage to the governmental entity prior to being awarded the contract.
4. If the coverage period shown on the contractor's current certificate of coverage ends during the duration of the project, the contractor must, prior to the end of the coverage period, file a new certificate of coverage with the governmental entity showing that coverage has been extended.
5. The Contractor shall obtain from each person providing services on a project, and provide to the

governmental entity:

(a) a certificate of coverage, prior to that person beginning work on the project, so the governmental entity will have on file certificates of coverage for all persons providing services on the project; and

(b) no later than seven days after receipt by the contractor, a new certificate of coverage showing extension of coverage, if the coverage period shown on the current certificate of coverage ends during the duration of the project.

6. The Contractor shall retain all required certificates of coverage for the duration of the project and for one year thereafter.

**PROHIBITION ON CONTRACTS WITH
COMPANIES BOYCOTTING ISRAEL**

Chapter 2271 of the Texas Government Code provides that the City may not enter into a contract* with a company for goods or services unless the contract contains a written verification from the company that it: (i) does not Boycott Israel; and (ii) will not Boycott Israel during the term of the contract.

“Boycott Israel” is defined to mean refusing to deal with, terminating business activities with, or otherwise taking any action that is intended to penalize, inflict economic harm on, or limit commercial relations specifically with Israel, or with a person or entity doing business in Israel or in an Israeli-controlled territory, but does not include an action made for ordinary business purposes. “Company” is defined to mean a for-profit organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of those entities or business associations that exists to make a profit.

PROPOSAL EVALUATION

RFP shall be awarded to the best-quoted proposal. The proposals will be evaluated on the factors outlined below which shall be applied to all eligible, responsive proposals in selecting the successful offeror. Award of a contract may be made without discussion with proposers after responses are received. Proposals should, therefore, be submitted on the most favorable terms.

Sealed Proposal Submission

Proposals shall be sealed and clearly marked with the Proposer's name and return address and indicate the proposal number and title. Facsimile or e-mail submitted proposals will not be accepted. Responses received after the deadline cannot be considered and will be returned unopened. The City is not responsible for delays occasioned by the U.S. Postal Service, the internal mail delivery system of the City, or any other delivery method employed by the Proposer.

Proposers or their authorized representatives are expected to fully inform themselves as to the general terms and conditions, requirements and specification of this Proposal Invitation before submitting proposals. Failure to do so will be at the proposer's own risk.

Negotiations may be conducted with responsible proposers who submit proposals determined to be susceptible of being selected for award. **All proposers will be accorded fair and equal treatment with respect to any opportunity for negotiation and revision of proposals.** Revisions to proposals may be permitted after submission and before award for the purpose of obtaining best and final offers.

PROPOSAL INFORMATION

Scope of Services

To establish a MULTI-VENDOR or SINGLE VENDOR with MULTIPLE LOCATIONS contract to perform preventative maintenance on light-duty vehicles (up to 1 ton gasoline and diesel-powered) for CITY OF MESQUITE vehicles in accordance with specifications described within the contract.

Vendor Qualifications

The VENDOR(S) must have proof that they have been doing business legally in the CITY OF MESQUITE for a period of no less than 3 years. The VENDOR(S) place of business must be within the CITY OF MESQUITE'S territorial jurisdiction (City limit). If the VENDOR is a single owner of multiple locations of the same business, each location must submit a proposal for consideration.

Contractor Duties

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall supply all materials, equipment, labor, and other items needed to perform and execute the work (hereinafter referred to as the "Work") described in the Scope of Services. The Work will be performed on the equipment at the CONTRACTOR(S)'s place of business, or in case of emergency, at the location of the vehicle or equipment. Equipment Services will provide the CONTRACTOR(S) with such permissions as required for access to the sites. The Work shall be performed in accordance with generally accepted industry standards, practices, and principles applicable to the work, and the worksites are maintained reasonably free of trash and waste materials. The CONTRACTOR(S) shall supervise and direct the Work and shall be solely responsible for and in control of the means, methods, procedures, techniques, and sequences of doing the Work. Except as otherwise provided in the Scope of Work, the CONTRACTOR(S) shall pay for all labor, equipment, tools, transportation, sub-CONTRACTOR(S) fees, and other items needed to perform and execute the Work.

Schedule

The preventative maintenance work will be performed according to the specifications attached herein. The CONTRACTOR(S) will be required to coordinate with the User department to schedule preventative or extended maintenance, repairs, and inspections. The CONTRACTOR(S) will obtain permission prior to beginning any work beyond the work considered as preventative maintenance such as extended service work or repairs to vehicles that are recommended due to defects found during the inspection or preventative maintenance process. Any SAFETY defects discovered during the preventive maintenance inspection should be reported immediately to the Equipment Services Supervisor or designated representative.

Additional Work

Any repairs identified during the performance of preventative maintenance shall be described and submitted in writing along with an estimated cost of repair. Equipment Services must approve the repair prior to such repair being undertaken.

Custody and Care of Property

The CONTRACTOR(S) agrees that s/he shall be responsible for the proper custody and care of any vehicles or property furnished for use in connection with the performance of this contract or purchased by it for this contract (i.e., repair manuals) and will reimburse the CITY OF MESQUITE for loss or damage of such property. The CITY OF MESQUITE's vehicles and trailers should be stored in a secure location if it is necessary for them to remain in the CONTRACTOR(S) custody overnight.

Supervision and Superintendence

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall supervise, inspect, and direct the Work competently and efficiently, devoting such attention thereto and applying such skills and expertise as may be necessary to perform the Work in accordance with the Owner's requirements.

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall provide competent, suitably qualified personnel to complete the Work as required by these documents. The CONTRACTOR(S) shall at all times maintain good discipline and order at the Site.

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall give all notices required by and shall comply with all Laws and Regulations applicable to the performance of the Work. If CONTRACTOR(S) performs any Work knowing or having reason to know that it is contrary to Laws or Regulations, CONTRACTOR(S) shall bear all claims, costs, losses, and damages (including but not limited to all fees and charges of engineers, architects, attorneys, and other professionals and all court or arbitration or other dispute resolution costs) arising out of or relating to such Work.

Safety and Protection

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall be solely responsible for initiating, maintaining, and supervising all safety precautions and programs in connection with the Work. The CONTRACTOR(S) shall take all necessary precautions for the safety of, and shall provide the necessary protection to prevent damage, injury or loss to (1) all persons on the Site or who may be affected by the Work, and (2) all the Work and materials and equipment to be incorporated therein, whether in the storage on or off the Site. The CONTRACTOR(S) shall comply with all Applicable Laws and Regulations relating to the safety of persons or property, or to the protection of persons or property from damage, injury, or loss; and shall erect and maintain all necessary safeguards for such safety and protection. All damage, injury, or loss to any property referred to in this Safety and Protection section caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by CONTRACTOR(S), any Sub-CONTRACTOR(S), Supplier, or any other individual or entity directly or indirectly employed by any of them to perform any of the Work, or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, shall be remedied by CONTRACTOR(S) (except damage or loss attributable to the acts or omissions of the CITY OF MESQUITE or anyone employed by any of them, or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, and not attributable, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, to the fault or negligence of CONTRACTOR(S) or any Sub-CONTRACTOR(S), Supplier, or other individual or entity directly or indirectly employed by any of them). The CONTRACTOR(S)'s duties and responsibilities for the safety and for protection of the Work shall continue until such time as all the Work is completed and the CITY OF MESQUITE has accepted the work. The CITY OF MESQUITE is committed to providing safe conditions for employees, CONTRACTOR(S), VENDOR(S), and visitors while occupying CITY OF MESQUITE facilities. Strict adherence to State and Federal OSHA and EPA Regulations will be required.

Hazard Communication Programs:

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall be responsible for coordinating any exchange of material safety data sheets or other hazard communication information required to be made available to or exchanged between or among employees at the Site in accordance with Laws or Regulations.

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall comply with all traffic laws and regulations while the vehicle is in the CONTRACTOR(S)'s custody and care.

Personnel

It is mutually agreed that the VENDOR(S) is an independent contractor and not an agent or employee of the City OF MESQUITE nor does this create any type of joint employment relationship with any of the employees of the VENDOR(S). As such, the VENDOR(S) or any employees thereof, or subcontractors, or any of its employees

thereof, shall not be entitled to any CITY OF MESQUITE employment benefits, such as, but not limited to wages or salary, vacation, sick leave, insurance, workers' compensation, or pension and retirement benefits.

SERVICE TURN-AROUND TIMES:

All CITY OF MESQUITE vehicles will receive priority treatment.
Priority is described as placed next in cue upon arrival at location.
Turnaround times are actual working times for specified PM by schedule.

Gasoline vehicles

Preventative Maintenance "A" service and multi-point inspection – Not to exceed 1 hour.
Preventative Maintenance "B" service and multi-point inspection – Not to exceed 1 hour and 30 minutes.
Preventative Maintenance "C" service and multi-point inspection – Not to exceed 2 hours.

Diesel vehicles

Preventative Maintenance "A" service and multi-point inspection – Not to exceed 1 hour and 30 minutes.
Preventative Maintenance "B" service and multi-point inspection – Not to exceed 2 hours.
Preventative Maintenance "C" service and multi-point inspection – Not to exceed 2 hours and 30 minutes.

Subcontracts

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall utilize no subcontracts for carrying out the services to be performed under this agreement without the written approval of the CITY OF MESQUITE.

Acceptable filters and petroleum products

Only filters and petroleum products that meet or exceed the manufacturer's guidelines shall be used when performing preventative maintenance on the CITY OF MESQUITE vehicles.

Invoicing

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall bill the CITY OF MESQUITE on an as-completed basis for any preventative maintenance work. Invoices shall be submitted no more than 2 business days after work is completed. All labor, parts, regulatory fees, and freight charges should be itemized to show the total cost of each item. Invoices shall include unit number, mileage or hours, description of item(s), quantities, unit price, extended price, freight, date of service, time vehicle submitted for service, and time the vehicle service is complete. Invoices should be submitted to the Administrative Secretary at Equipment Services by email for payment.

Records

The contractor shall maintain all records, documents, notes, and financial information related to the performance of the Work in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and practices and shall provide the CITY OF MESQUITE access to such information if requested. Any information, data, instruments, documents, studies or reports given to or prepared or assembled by the CONTRACTOR(S) under this agreement shall be kept as confidential and not divulged or made available to any individual or organization without the prior written approval of the CITY OF MESQUITE.

Errors/Deficiencies

The CONTRACTOR(S) shall, without additional compensation, make any corrections to inferior or incomplete work done under this agreement if it is determined that the CONTRACTOR(S) is responsible for any errors or deficiencies.

Suspension or Termination of Agreement

1. In the event that a review of the CONTRACTOR(S)'s performance shows non-conformance to the work required by this contract, the Scope of Services or other terms or conditions contained herein as a result of the CONTRACTOR(S)'s negligent errors, omissions or acts, the CONTRACTOR(S) shall be in breach of this agreement and the CITY OF MESQUITE may take corrective action as it deems necessary including, but not limited to, termination, withholding or reduction of payment.

2. The CITY OF MESQUITE shall also have the right to suspend this agreement upon written notice to the CONTRACTOR(S). Such written notice shall state the reasons for suspension and allow for a review period of ten (10) days during which the CONTRACTOR(S) shall be provided with an opportunity to respond with an explanation or justification, and/or shall undertake any reasonable remedial action required by the CITY OF MESQUITE. If, in the opinion of the CITY OF MESQUITE, the CONTRACTOR(S) remains in violation of this agreement at the completion of the ten (10) day suspension period, the CITY OF MESQUITE shall have the right to terminate this agreement whereupon all obligations of the CITY OF MESQUITE to the CONTRACTOR(S) shall cease.

3. In the event this project is terminated prior to completion of the services by the CONTRACTOR(S), the CONTRACTOR(S) shall be paid for services performed to the date of termination. The CONTRACTOR(S) shall be paid for all reimbursable, as defined herein, which are due him.

4. This agreement may be terminated without cause by the CITY OF MESQUITE with thirty (30) days written notice to the CONTRACTOR(S).

5. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the CITY OF MESQUITE from pursuing any other remedy which it may have against CONTRACTOR(S) including claims for damages.
